ACCOUNTANT'S COMPILATION REPORT

Dear Board of Directors,

The financial statements of Stichting Musicians Without Borders at Amsterdam have been compiled by us using the information provided by you. The financial statements comprise the balance sheet as at 31 December 2016 and the profit and loss account for the year 2016 with the accompanying explanatory notes. These notes include a summery of the accounting policies which have been applied.

This compilation engagement has been performed by us in accordance with Dutch law, including the Dutch Standard 4410, "Compilation engagements", which is applicable to accountants. The standard requires us to assist you in the preparation and presentation of the financial statements in accordance with accounting policies generally accepted in the Netherlands. To this end we have applied our professional expertise in accounting and financial reporting.

In a compilation engagement, you are responsible for ensuring that you provide us with all relevant information and that this information is correct. Therefore, we have conducted our work in accordance with the applicable regulations, on the assumption that you have fulfilled your responsibility. To conclude our work, we have read the financial statements as a whole to consider whether the financial statements as presented correspond with our understanding of Musicians Without Borders. We have not performed any audit or review procedures which would enable us to express an opinion or a conclusion as to the fair presentation of the financial statements.

During this engagement we have complied with the relevant ethical requirements prescribed by the "Verordening Gedrags- en Beroepsregels Accountants" (VGBA). You and other users of these financial statements may therefore assume that we have conducted the engagement in a professional, competent and objective manner and with due care and integrity and that we will treat all information provided to us as confidential.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY (by the foundation)

During the year 2016, the total expenditures amounted to € 515,829 (2015: € 402,775) of which € 441,133 (2015: € 354,095) was spent on objectives, € 40,046 (2015: € 29,060) on fundraising and € 34,650 (2015: € 19,620) on Management and Administration.

The total expenditures on objectives can be split between projects costs (\in 353,454) and costs of information, education and awareness-raising actions (\in 87,679). Of the total expenditures in 2016, 86% was spent on objectives.

The significant increase in expenditures on objectives, in comparison to the year 2015 (about 25%), is mainly due to the successful continuation of the music projects, the implementation of new projects started in the Netherlands and in Uganda, and the further development of MwB's Training Program: in 2016 the program included a second annual professional Training of Trainers, held in the Netherlands; the development of new advanced community music training in partnership with The School for Oriental and African Studies (University of London - UK) and The School for International Training in Vermont (USA); and a training curriculum and course for the new project, Welcome Notes tailored to address the situation of refugees in the Netherlands and in Europe.

The general and fundraising costs do not show any significant change. The organization maintained its relatively low percentage of income spent on management, administration and fundraising in line with the budget. The slightly increase in 2016 is mainly due to extra funds made available to hire a professional fundraiser during the last quarter of 2016.

The overhead costs slightly increased in 2016, due to additional costs linked to the administration of the personnel under payroll.

The total income for 2016 was \in 587,069 (2015: \in 410,067). The total income was generated by the organization's own fundraising activities, augmented by merchandise campaigns and benefit events in the Netherlands and around the world. Of the total income, 64% (\in 375,469) was granted for projects and the remaining 36% (\in 211,600) was raised as general income. Of the total income in 2016, 75% was spent on objectives.


This year was marked by a significant increase in income compared to the year 2015; the organization's result exceeded the budget. The organization, working under cost restriction until mid-2016, through the efficient use of existing staff, volunteers and interns, succeeded in meeting its fundraising goals for 2016 and additionally allied with a strategic partner willing to invest in general organization development. The new strategic partner's financial support resulted in a slight increase of the staff capacity, as well as critical support for existing and new projects and activities. During the last quarter of the year 2016, it was therefore possible to slightly increase the hours of the current personnel, already understaffed, and to stabilize the work of our project managers and external professionals. The search for a strategic partner was important for the organization in order to strengthen its overall capacities and work, to ensure a better level of financial sustainability, especially through the creation of a continuity reserve so that in case of funds shortage the organization and its operations are not immediately affected.

The continuation of this partnership in the future is not certain but the organization will continue to pursue the strategy of concentrating its human and financial resources mainly on its projects, events and communications to raise awareness and disseminate information about the mission and activities of Musicians without Borders. This strategy continues to result in a growing number of benefit events, concerts and individual contributors.



It is important to note that a portion of funds raised by Musicians without Borders for its projects is not included in this report, as these funds have not passed through Musicians without Borders' accounts, as they have gone directly to our local partners in the project regions. This is particularly relevant in the case of the Mitrovica Rock School, and with lesser amounts, in the cases of the projects Rwanda Youth Music and Palestine Community Music. In any case, Musicians without Borders continues to support its local partners in every aspect linked to its projects, especially with the fundraising and capacity building, as strategic areas for the future development of the project locally.

The result of 2016 shows a surplus of income over expenditures of \in 71,240, part of which has increased the allocation reserve and funds, \in 11,339 (\in 45,627) and the remaining part is added to the general reserve (\in 59,901) that insures the organization's continuity in case of any possible adverse future financial situation.







PRINCIPLES OF VALUATION

GENERAL

The annual accounts are drawn up according to the accounting principles generally accepted in the Netherlands pursuing RJ 650 (Fundraising Organizations). The annual account is in Euros and will be compared by the board with the approved budget 2016 and the actual account 2016.

GENERAL NOTES FOR VALUATION ASSETS AND LIABILITIES

Receivables and liabilities

Receivables are recognized at nominal value, less any provision of doubtful accounts. The current liabilities are recognized at nominal value.

PRINCIPLES OF DETERMINATION OF RESULT

General

Revenues and expenses in the statement of income and expenses are allocated to the period to which they relate. The result is determined as the difference between income generated by contributions and other sources, and the costs and other charges for the year.

Costs allocation

The expenses are attributed to the year to which they relate.

All costs are allocated among the cost categories "expenditures on objectives", "expenditures for generate income" and "overhead and administration". This was done by the VFI expressed breakdown of other costs.

CASH FLOW OVERVIEW

The cash flow overview is compiled according to the indirect method. Cash flows from foreign currencies are converted with the average exchange rate. Exchange rate differences are shown separately in the cash flow overview. The received and paid interest is included in the cash flow from operational activities.
