1 COMPILATION REPORT

Audit

In accordance with your instructions we have compiled the annual account 2021 of the foundation, including the balance sheet totals of € 144,163 and the statement of revenue and expenditure with a result of € 76,561.

Management's responsibility

The distinctive feature of a compilation engagement is that we compile financial information based on information provided by management of the foundation. Management is responsible for the accuracy and completeness of the information provided and the financial statements based thereon.

Confirmation

Based on the information provided to us, we have compiled the financial statements using the accounting policies as included in generally accepted principles for financial reporting in the Netherlands.



2 GENERAL

2.1 Foundation

The activities of Stichting United Way The Netherlands relate mainly to the improvement of economic, social and cultural conditions by improving the quality of life of people and their communities. The foundation is a so called Algemeen Nut Beoogde Instelling (ANBI) at a non-profit basis.

2.2 Board

On December 31, 2021 the board of directors is formed by P.M. Weiss (chairman), S.C. van Groningen (secretary), Mrs. J.M. van Karnebeek-Thijssen (treasurer), Mrs. H.M.C. Hulsebosch and V.W. van Gogh. The members of the Board of the foundation are unpaid.

2.3 Foundation of the foundation

By notarial deed of 2019 January 15th, notary Mr. Alexander Stuijt in Haarlem, the foundation was founded as Stichting United Way The Netherlands. Activities are starting that date in name of and for risk of the foundation.

1 MANAGEMENT REPORT

The report of the management is presented on the next page.



This annual report provides information about the performance, financial and otherwise, of United Way the Netherlands (UW-NL) in 2021, in compliance with the norms and standards set by United Way Worldwide. At the outset we wish to thank our donors, partners and volunteers for the enormous trust they place on us.

Donations

- UW-NL succeeded in raising a total amount of €299,277.- in 2021 a 37% increase from €217,849.- in 2020. Key donors included the Internet Society Foundation (ISOF), which donated USD 225,000.-, and TotalEnergies.
- We also received donations from several Dutch foundations including Sluyterman Van Loo, Oranjefonds, and RCOAK. Our loyal "de Tocqueville" society members decided to contribute, for the third year in a row, close to €40,000.-

Community Impact

- In 2021 the Netherlands experienced protracted lockdowns due to the COVID-19 pandemic, creating unique circumstances to which UW-NL had to quickly adapt.
 Together with our colleagues in Spain, we matched a total of 300 isolated elderly individuals with an equal number of volunteers with a refugee or migration background through our project *Joining Forces*. This proved very effective at reducing the negative impact of covid lockdowns on both the elderly and refugees.
- UW-NL assisted 135 young adults with financial help through our project Get a Grip, implemented by Humanitas. This project is aimed at combating poverty among adolescent youth in high-risk urban areas by providing financial literacy education to mitigate youth debt burden.
- We initiated research into the feasibility of getting involved in an environmental project implemented by Natuur & Milieu, an organization working on solutions for climate and nature-related problems in the Netherlands.

Partners and Volunteers

- In the past few years we have professionalized our social media outreach with the help of a Netherlands-based digital marketing expert. This has greatly helped our recruitment of new volunteers, the role of whom continues to be a key factor in achieving our goals.
- In total, 180 volunteers have been recruited to work on the various projects listed on our website. UW-NL filled 1.6 paid staff positions with individuals working on a part-time basis (0.3 employees on a full-time basis).

- As a result of the successful implementation during the first phase of the *Joining Forces* project, ISOF invited us to submit a follow-up appeal for the years 2022/2023. For this 2022 submission, talks have been initiated with our new partner offices in the UK, Romania, Germany and Israel to join the existing cooperation of the Netherlands and Spain.
- Our special appreciation is extended to our outstanding partners Humanitas, Netwerkpro, Helpdigitaal, Combiwel and de Vrijwilligers academie.

3 NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

GENERAL

Registered office, legal form and registration number at the chamber of commerce

The registered and actual address of Stichting United Way The Netherlands is Keizersgracht 370C,in Amsterdam. It is registered at the chamber of commerce under number 73715158.

GENERAL ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES FOR THE PREPARATION OF THE ANNUAL ACCOUNTS

The financial statements are using the accounting policies as included in generally accepted principles for financial reporting in the Netherlands.

Valuation of assets and liabilities and determination of the result takes place under the historical cost convention. Unless presented otherwise at the relevant principle for the specific balance sheet item, assets and liabilities are presented at nominal value.

Income and expenses are accounted for on accrual basis. Revenues are only included when realized on the balance sheet date. Expenses originating before the end of the financial year are taken into account if they have become known before preparation of the financial statements.

Revenues from goods are recognised upon delivery. The expenses of these goods is allocated to the same period. Revenues from services are recognised in proportion to the services rendered. The expenses of these services are allocated to the same period.

ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES APPLIED TO THE VALUATION OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES

Securities

Securities are registered at nominal value.

Cash and cash equivalents

The cash is valued at face value. If cash equivalents are not freely disposable, then this has been taken into account in the valuation.

Current liabilities

On initial recognition current liabilities are recognised at fair value. After initial recognition current liabilities are recognised at the amortised cost price.



ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES FOR THE DETERMINATION OF THE RESULT

Determination of the result

The result is determined based upon the difference between the revenue and expenditure and other expenses taking into account the aforementioned valuation principles.

Employee benefits

General

Employee expenses (wages, salaries, social security contributions, etc.) are presented as a separate item in the statement of expenses.

Financial income and expenses

Interest income and interest expenses

Interest income and expenses are recognised on a pro rata basis, taking account of the effective interest rate of the assets and liabilities to which they relate. In accounting for interest expenses, the recognised transaction expenses for loans received are taken into consideration.

Currency translation differences

Currency translation differences arising upon the settlement or conversion of monetary items are recognised in the income statement in the period that they are realised, unless hedge accounting is applied.
